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SELF-ASSESSMENT TOOL FOR STUDENTS

In the project we will develop various training modules that teachers can use to train their students. But before doing this, we first must **identify the needs for the students**.

To find out what these needs for training are, the expert partners developed a self-assessment instrument to **assess how students are performing on the 10 Life Skills**. All project partners contributed to the development of the instrument, by prioritising which topics are the most important and by validating the indicators that came out of that work. In the upcoming months, all VET partners will test the tool in order to set a norm: minimum level of performance. When a person performs under this norm for a Life Skill, additional training is recommended.

The tool consists of 50 statements, 5 for each Life Skill, which can be responded in a 7-point scale. When a person fills in the assessment instrument, a personal profile will be generated on which one can see the performance for each Life Skill. This gives information for the teacher to design tailor-made training. The assessment instrument will also generate a profile for a group, so teachers may be able to design and to provide even customized training for an individual and for a group.

Modules for Creative Teaching

In **December 2023**, the project partners came together in **Tallinn (Estonia)** in order to start the process of co-designing the training modules about Creative Teaching linked to all 10 Life Skills.

Goals for the meeting were to **understand the concept of Creative Teaching**; to match Life Skills to different approaches of Creative Teaching and to **co-design the Train-The-Trainer sessions** for the Transnational Meeting in May 2024 in Padova (Italy). Each Creative Teaching session will be structured according to three key elements:

- Creating Awareness
- Training of competences
- Practicing and how to these competences in Life Skill training/education.

The **goal** of the Transnational Meeting in **May 2024 (Padova)** is that:

Teachers/trainers acquire Creative Teaching competences how to train Life Skills to their students.

As result of the co-production, a compendium with various Creative Teaching methods to train the 10 Life Skills will be developed and made available for other VET-providers.
